

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARKING AFTER SNOWFALL

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER ORDAINS:

Chapter 34, Article III, Section 34-66 of the Clearwater, MN City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 34-66. Parking after snowfall.

~~After a snowfall of at least two inches or a wet slushy snowfall of any amount, it is a petty misdemeanor for any person to fail to remove a motor vehicle or parts thereof from any street or alley until the snowplowing on the street or alley is completed.~~

Following any snowfall between the dates of November 1 of each year to April 1 of the year next following, it shall be unlawful to park or leave standing any vehicle or part thereof on any street or alleyway from 2:00 o'clock AM until such time as snow plowing curb-to-curb has been completed on such street or alleyway. If a vehicle or part thereof is found in violation of this provision it may be towed at the owner's expense.

This ordinance is effective on the day following its publication as provided by law.
